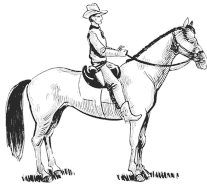

On November 20th, Newman received national accreditation for three essential programs: Critical Access Hospital, Rural Health Clinic, and Laboratory Services. This achievement makes Newman the first organization in Oklahoma to be recognized across all three areas.
